The slender sheartail Hummingbird" (Doricha enicura) is a small and elusive bird of montane forests in Guatemala and Central America, known for its long, forked tail, curved bill, and green plumage with a throat that appears purple in males. This little friend is recognized for its low or close-to-the-ground flights and the movement it makes with

its tail resembles that of scissors.

This is an ideal painting for a bright space. The soft colors and the light it projects can fill the space with a peaceful, patient energy, and its tail, which cuts away everything that is no longer useful in your life, is a protective element.

This multicolored hummingbird (*Lamprolaima rhami*) is a species native to Mexico and Central America known as the garnet throated hummingbird. Its most striking feature is its brilliant brown wings, which typically shimmer as it flits from flower to flower.

It is a large and spectacular hummingbird that inhabits highlands. In Guatemala, it can be seen in the Cuchumatanes

mountains at an altitude of 3,700 meters above sea level. They come to feed on the nectar produced by the flowers (*Kniphofia uvaria*).

This hummingbird is a riot of color and grace, and together with the vibrant orange of its flowers, it symbolizes energy, creativity, enthusiasm, and a period of personal transformation or joy.

“THE MOUNTAIN GUARDIAN”

The Guatemalan Wine-throated Hummingbird (*Selasphorus ellioti*) is a very small bird, measuring 6.5cm in length. It is among the smallest birds in its range, and also one of the most beautiful. It inhabits mountainous regions, specifically cloud forests and wooded slopes, often above 2,000 meters high! This colorful guy brings total harmony to a typical guatemalan landscape of volcanos. It fills the air with the calm energy of a guardian of beauty and color.

The red broom, also known as bottlebrush, is very attractive to hummingbirds in Guatemala. Bees and hummingbirds compete for the nectar of the red broom (*Callistemon citrinus*), although in different ways. The presence of bees can sometimes deter hummingbirds from visiting the flowers.

This is because bees can be perceived as a threat by hummingbirds since they are very small creatures. The hummingbird in this work is the White-eared Hummingbird (*Basilinna leucotis*) which is a territorial species of hummingbird that measures approx 9cm that is also very prudent!

High atop the Sierra de las Minas—a biosphere reserve and wildlife sanctuary—a hummingbird (*Amazilia tzacatl*) prepares for its tireless journey. Its tiny body, driven by a metabolism that grants it no rest, seems to pause for a moment before the dawn: the golden light that heralds a new beginning. That brief second, suspended between rest and flight,

It symbolizes the spark that renews hope and reminds us that each day offers the opportunity to begin anew. The soft palette of greens, golds, and violets conveys calm, balance, and the serenity that precedes action.

A very large, spectacular, and powerful hummingbird, the Violet Sabrewing (*Campylopterus hemileucurus*) is one of the most striking species found in the humid highland forests of Belize and Guatemala. The male's extraordinary violet plumage often appears almost black at first glance — but when it catches the light, it reveals an

intense, luminous purple that feels almost electric.

In this painting, he is captured feeding from a banana flower, suspended in a moment of strength and vitality. This piece has the presence to fill a room with light and determination — the kind of energy that evokes resilience, confidence, and quiet achievement.

Two birds of paradise from Guatemala! One is a flower, and the other is the White-eared Hummingbird (*Basilinna leucotis*), also known as the White-eared Hummingbird. These territorial hummingbirds spend most of their time in the lower and middle levels of the forest, where they are particularly common near low-lying flower beds. The White-eared Hummingbird is a small to medium-sized hummingbird (averaging 9 cm).

The nests are often placed very close to one another and are sometimes even built on top of old nests.

These beautiful specimens remind me of the importance of living in peace and not wasting anything.

The buffy helmetcrest (*Oxygogon stuebelii*) is a Vulnerable species of hummingbird. It is a large, short-billed hummingbird found only at extremely high elevations in the central Andes of Colombia. This uniquely beautiful creature lives in cold, drizzly conditions that constantly challenge its survival. When foraging, individuals cling to flowers or sometimes even walk along the ground, wobbling in search of insects.

The total population of this species is perhaps only a thousand individuals, and it inhabits no other part of the world.

This work is a tribute to this amazing guy, in an attempt to make him immortal and, also to remind us that we are all as unique as he is, and could disappear at any moment, which is why it is worthwhile to appreciate every minute that life grants us.

The Violet Sabrewing (*Campylopterus hemileucurus*) and *Heliconia* flowers share a specialized ecological relationship in the tropical forests of Central America. The Violet Sabrewing is a "traplining" feeder, meaning it follows a regular, daily route to visit specific flowering plants. *Heliconias* are among the bird's favorite nectar sources. Species like *Heliconia tortuosa* and *Heliconia beckneri* rely on the Sabrewing for pollination.

The special relationship between the Violet Sabrewing and *Heliconia* is a rare example of "pollinator recognition," where the plant can actually choose to be fertilized only by specific birds. What an incredible mission!

Life can depend on such tiny creatures, and yet people sometimes think their lives lack purpose. This little one reminds us that you already serve an important purpose by doing the simplest things in life.

The long-billed hermit (*Phaethornis longirostris*) is a large hummingbird (measuring approximately 14-15 centimeters in length) of humid tropical lowlands. It primarily prefers flowers of the Heliconia family, in this case, the torch lily (*Etlingera elatior*).

When feeding, it hovers for a moment with the white stripes of its tail held almost vertically and then darts off with a loud chirp.

Unlike many hummingbirds, the Long-billed Hermit actively explores the forest in search of flowers, visiting a variety of plants distributed throughout its habitat, a strategy known as "routing."

This hummingbird inspires me to step outside my comfort zone and dare to explore and create new adventures.

The extremely short beak of the purple-backed short-billed woodpecker (*Ramphomicron microrhynchum*), a specific evolutionary adaptation, responds mainly to a dietary specialization to forage on small and often robust or tubular flowers in its Andean habitat. This design allows for greater

mechanical efficiency in nectar extraction compared to longer beaks, and also facilitates the consumption of small insects and the behavior of "stealing" nectar by piercing the base of the flower.

This little friend reminds us that being unusual doesn't mean being inadequate, but quite the opposite!

The second is that the chicks hatch with a very unusual down that allows them to mimic toxic caterpillars to scare away predators. So, this hummingbird's energy is the perfect symbol of ingenious adaptation.

Hummingbirds use their vision to find flowers, especially bright red and orange flowers. They are attracted to these colors because they have a higher sugar content than other flowers. A study published in the journal Nature Communications in 2017 revealed that hummingbirds are able to remember each flower they visit and its location, which helps them optimize their search for food.

Hummingbirds typically visit between 1,000 and 2,000 flowers per day to sustain their extremely high metabolism. Due to their need to feed every 10–15 minutes, they consume nectar and small insects throughout the day, to meet their caloric requirements. These tiny birds never cease to amaze me with their incredible skills for adaptation and survival.

The male's upperparts are bright green; the underparts cinnamon buff; the throat and sides of the breast have green discs; the tail is coppery green.
